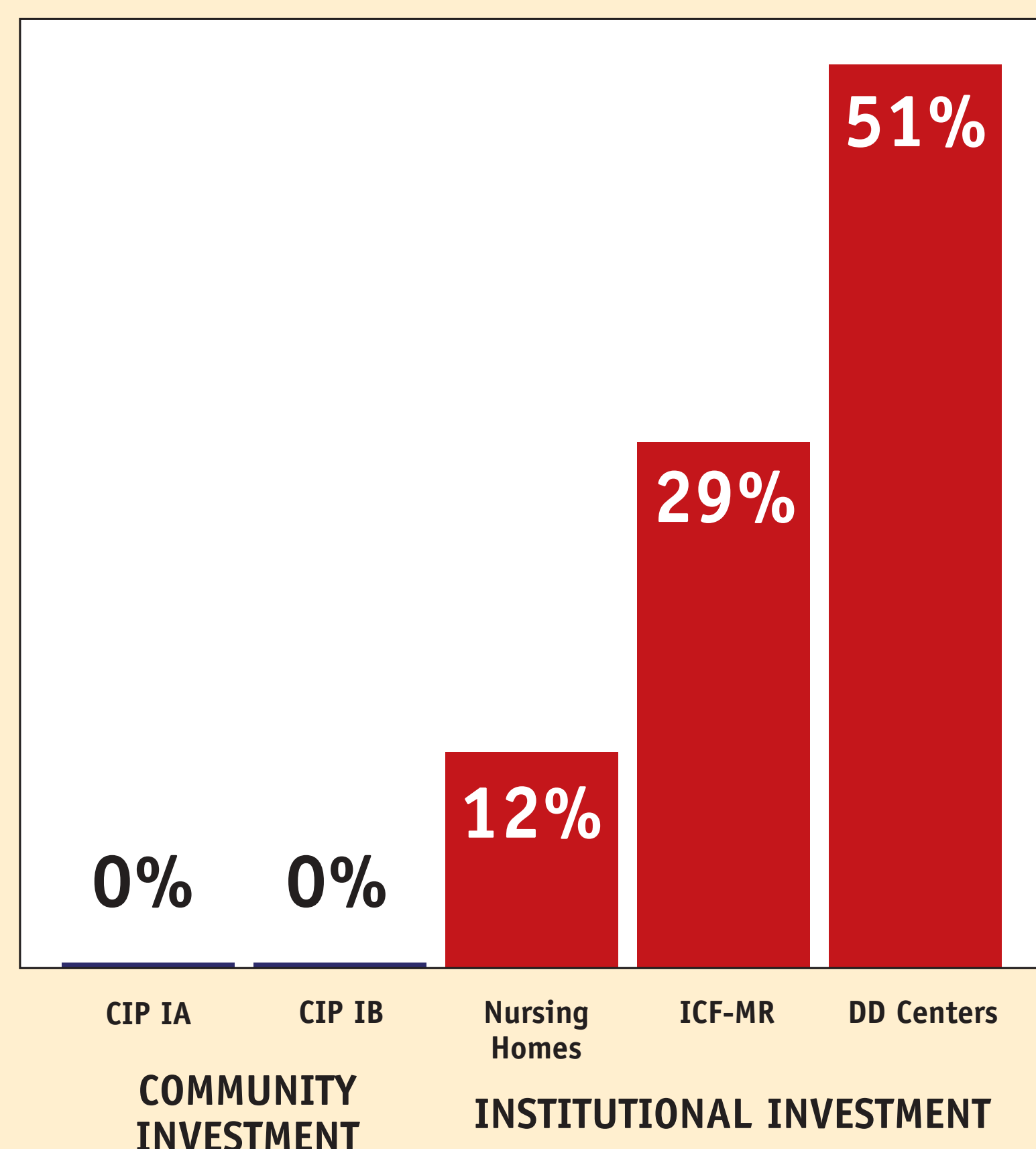
Adequate Wages and Health Insurance
